Notice:

Ramps at the sole discretion of the judge, approved breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp: Boykin Spaniels, Clumber Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Whippets, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden & Polish Lowland Sheepdogs. (Boykin Spaniels & Whippets may be judged on the table, ramp or the ground.)

Basset Hounds & Bulldogs are expected to be judged on the ramp during breed judging.

This list may be revised from time to time, and the current list can be found on the AKC website in Judging Operations.

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give reasonable notice to the Show Superintendent/Show Secretary prior to the day of the show. AKC approval is not required.

Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)

All Regular Classes are divided by sex and are offered for all breeds or varieties of breeds unless otherwise noted below. Where classes are further divided by color, weight, or other breed characteristics, it is so indicated below and the class division MUST be indicated on the entry form.

Amateur-Owner-Handler Class (effective as of 1/1/2009)

Chapter 3, Section 7 - The Amateur-Owner-Handler Class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

NR1.08100.27400. Veteran Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches eight (8) years & over.

FOR SAMOYEDS (SUNDAY ONLY)

NR1.08100.02400. Veteran Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches seven (7) years & under nine (9) years.

NR1.08100.36800. Veteran Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches nine (9) years & over.

00900. Best of Breed (*01000*. Variety) Competition

FOR STANDARD SCHNAUZERS (SUNDAY ONLY)

NR2.48700. Parade of Champions, Obedience & Performance Titlists - There will be a non-competitive parade for dogs that are AKC title holders of record. Each entrant will be awarded a Rosette, imprinted with the dog's name in gold leaf. Dogs entered in this class need not be entered in any other class. **Entry fee is \$15.00.**

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

FOR GREATER SWISS MOUNTAIN DOGS, MASTIFFS, SAMOYEDS & STANDARD SCHNAUZERS (SUNDAY ONLY)

NR2.09100. Stud Dog Class - Will be for Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed (Variety) Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class. **Entry fee is \$29.00 for the Stud Dog if not entered in another class; \$25.00 as an additional class.**

NR2.09200. Brood Bitch Class - Same as the Stud Dog, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety by virtue of having won these classes.

FOR MASTIFFS & STANDARD SCHNAUZERS (SUNDAY ONLY)

NR2.09300. Brace Class - (two dogs of the same breed or variety and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers.) - Brace Class will require a **entry fee of \$5.00 as a unit as an additional entry.** The dogs comprising a Brace **MUST** be named at time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in any of the Regular Classes or for Best of Breed Competition, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only" with **entry fee of \$12.00 per dog.** In making entries for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in a Regular Class or for Best of Breed Competition and entered as a part of a Brace **MUST** be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes, "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising **EACH** Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc.

Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring. **Class Cash Prizes** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. The Superintendents and showing Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.
